Directions to the Host Hotel

Follow the same directions as above. After turning left onto Price Rd, the hotel will be approximately 2 blocks and located on your left. Best Western Plus Prairie Inn.

Best Western Pet Policy

The hotel may charge a one-time, non-refundable pet fee of \$20.00 /pet per stay.
Additionally, if there is damage to the room or hotel, charges will be assessed and billed to individual guests.

Maximum of (4) dogs are allowed in each guest room. Any additional dogs in each guest room must be preapproved by the hotel. All dogs must have their own crate, with plastic under it. Guest rooms must be available for daily house cleaning and inspection by Hotel staff.

Under no circumstances will dog washing be permitted in hotel guest rooms. The hotel staff will report an infraction of this rule immediately to hotel management.

Owners/Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs inside and outside the hotel.

PARK RULES

NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN THE PARK

Start Clean, Stay Clean and Leave Clean! Our park use depends on our maintaining the grounds in pristine condition. Clean up all hair and debris regularly, not just when you leave at the end of the show. Be sure to treat park personnel with respect.

Do not contact Timber-Linn Memorial Park office with questions or requests. Doing so may result in revocation of entry privileges. If you have issues that are park related, please contact the Show Chairperson or the Grounds Chairperson. Abusive language will not be tolerated.

LOADING/UNLOADING

Loading and unloading will be from the parking lot. It will be a short walk to where canopies can be set up. Please come prepared. If you have any issues, call John Mayhall 928-970-0969.

GROOMING

Pop up canopies will be allowed 10 feet from the ring. One bathing tub will be available along with cold water. Electrical for blow dryers is limited. If you plan to use a portable generator, please contact the Grounds Chair to assist with location.

Passenger Vehicle Parking Options

Passenger vehicle parking is offered at no charge in the gravel lot. Please park in the lot near the pavilions and walk across the bridge.

RV Parking

1. Gravel lot RV Parking will be offered at \$35.00 per night. Dry camping ONLY/No power available. Use Reservation Form
2. Overnight spaces will be approximately 25' X 40'
3. Anyone wishing to be set up together, the reservation form must be submitted in the same envelope.

RV Regulations:

1. ALL overnight RVs must be fully self-contained.
2. THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO DUMPING OF GRAY WATER OR SEWAGE ON THE GROUND. A SUBSTANTIAL FINE WILL BE IMPOSED FOR INFRACTIONS.
3. If using a generator for any reason, the exhaust MUST be directed away from other RVs and exercise pens.
4. Generators must be turned off by 10 PM and start no earlier than 6 AM. Please respect the "quiet hours".
5. Everyone using the parking areas will be expected to leave their area clean – and essentially ALL areas of the site and in as good as, but preferably BETTER, conditions than when they arrived. Authorized receptacles must be used for all garbage, which must be bagged. Start Clean, Stay Clean, AND Leave Clean!
6. ALL dogs must be housed inside the RV at night. None will be permitted to be outside in crates or x-pens during sleep hours.
7. NO parking in designated FIRE LANES, Loading/Unloading zones or in areas other than that assigned. Violators will be towed without notice and at the owner's expense. All parking is at your own risk. None of the above-listed entities, including the sponsoring clubs, assume any responsibility for fire, theft and/or damage to any vehicle or its cargo.
