## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Incomplete, unsigned, telephone, telegraph, or entries without fees CANNOT be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the entry form are NOT acceptable. ANY ENTRY SENT VIA ANY EXPRESS METHOD MUST HAVE THE SIGNATURE WAIVED.

A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Entry forms and Agreement on reverse side (or attached to) of the entry form must be signed.

Entries must be on the enclosed entry form or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after entries have closed. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by veterinarian, judge, or tester or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial/test, no refund will be given.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS CONTINUED**

The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

Only dogs eligible to enter this Test/Trial will be allowed within the Test/Trial limits except that testers/judges may use a trained backup dog in settling or controlling the stock.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The Test/Trial giving club and Test/Trial Secretary have no responsibility or obligation for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the arena when required.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the arena.

Dogs must wear a simple well-fitting buckle, snap lock or slip collar (no tags) or may work without a collar at Trial levels.

Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of their class in tests and in catalog order in trials. Please notify the Herding Secretary if your bitch is in season.

Exhibitors shall be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities, building/facility rules, and parking restrictions.

All persons attending this trial hereby waive any claim for damages against Columbia River Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club, or its members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.

There is limited shade and/or cover available on site. Bring shade and/or cover for both yourself and your dogs. Also, bring water, chairs, and other necessary items for you and your dogs.

**AKC HERDING RULES AND REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 13. CLOSING OF ENTRIES/ALTERNATES LIST and MOVE UPS:**

- Whenever test or trial entry limits have been reached, all additional entries that are received prior to the closing date shall be added to an alternates list for each class that exceeds the published limit(s). Entries shall be added to their respective alternates list in the order that they are received and published in the catalog. No entries shall be added after the closing time and date specified in the premium list. The Herding Secretary shall notify all entrants of their positions and the alternates list at the time the test/trial program is mailed to each entrant. Those alternates that do not run or do not have the opportunity to run shall have their fees returned.
- The alternates list shall be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.
- Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class. Note: Requests to move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Alternates must run in their respective classes if present and if provided with the opportunity to run.
- In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternates shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.

Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier level (provided the alternate's level has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's level.

### **COVID-19 INFORMATION:**

Exhibitors, judges, volunteers and spectators will be required to comply with all facility, local, Washington State mandates and AKC Best Practices guidelines for Herding trials in place at the time of the event.

**Continuation of this event at Brigand's HideOut is contingent upon leaving the grounds in a clean and orderly condition. Please respect and do not destroy the trial site. And please, clean up after your dog. Only dog poop (properly bagged) shall be deposited in designated "poop" receptacles. Personal trash shall be disposed of in garbage cans.**

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
